

Anne Frank The Exhibition

For the first time in history, the Anne Frank House will present a pioneering experience outside of Amsterdam to immerse visitors in a full-scale recreation of the Annex, where Anne Frank, her parents and sister, and four other Jewish inhabitants spent two years hiding to evade Nazi capture.

Anne Frank The Exhibition gives visitors of all ages the chance to learn about Anne Frank, not as a victim but through the multifaceted lens of her life—as a girl, a writer, and a symbol of resilience and strength. More than 100 original collection items from the Anne Frank House in Amsterdam, including several never-before-exhibited artifacts, help to convey the context that shaped Anne's life, death and posthumous fame. Her diary is one of the most translated

books in the world.

Visiting the Anne Frank The Exhibition is a potential field trip idea where we would take a bus trip to NYC on **Sunday, April 27th** (which is one week after Passover ends and one week after Easter).

We would go see the Anne Frank exhibit at the Center for Jewish History. The approximate cost for charter bus (with bathroom) from synagogue to NYC and back, museum entrance fee, and half a sandwich at Katz's Deli would be \$110/person.

Arlene Levinson would plan on advertising the trip to the general public and also contact Chatham and Catskill synagogues.
